



Please review the paperwork for instructions on how to complete the process. Renewals should be submitted either online or via mail between January 1st and January 31st.


Late fees begin February 1st.



Join one of the MTPL's "Read to a Dog" sessions on either Thursday, January 11th or Monday, January 15th!




