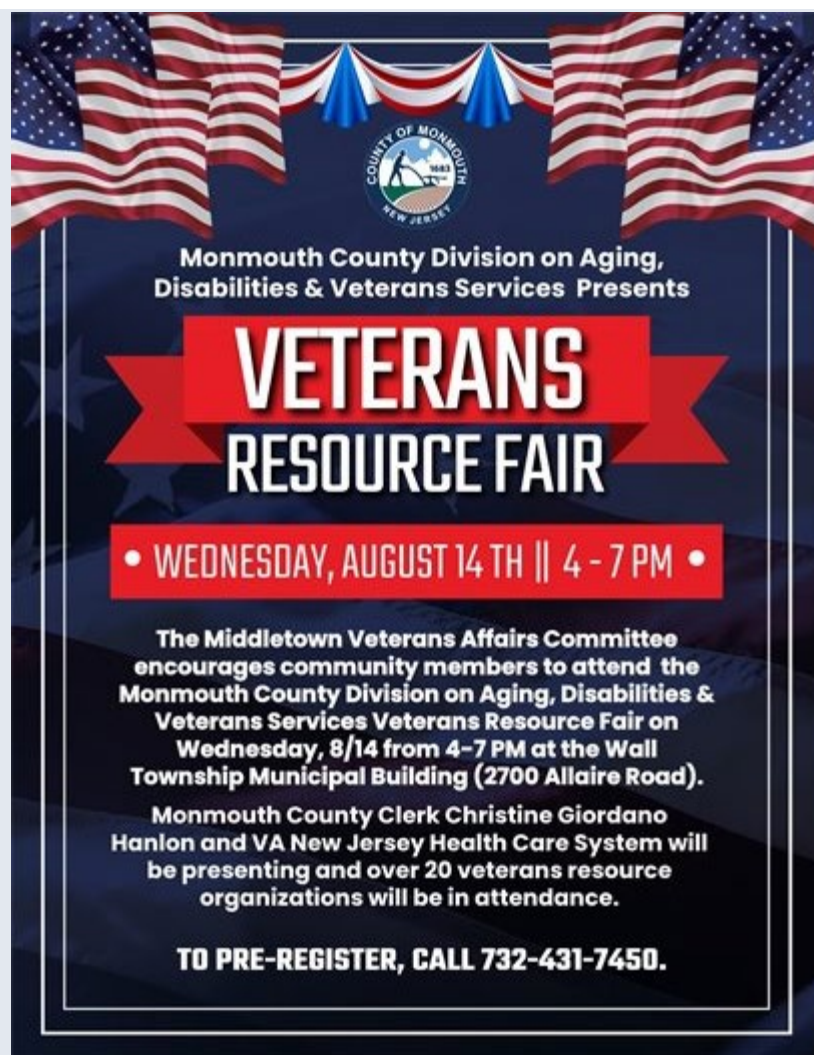


Calculate How Your Municipal Tax Dollars Are Being Spent



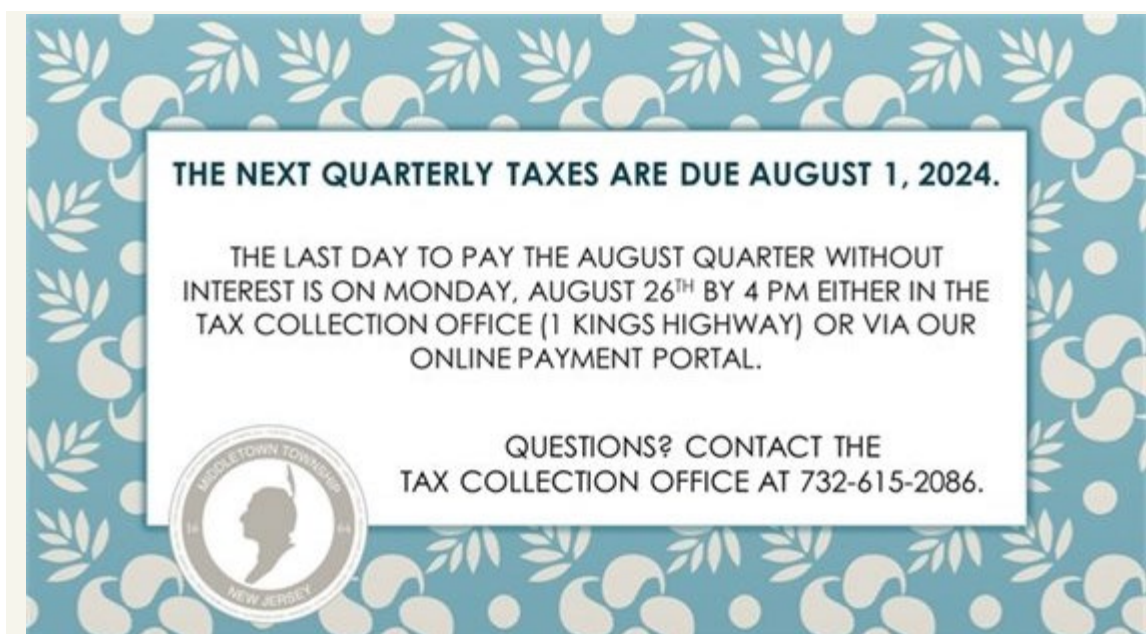

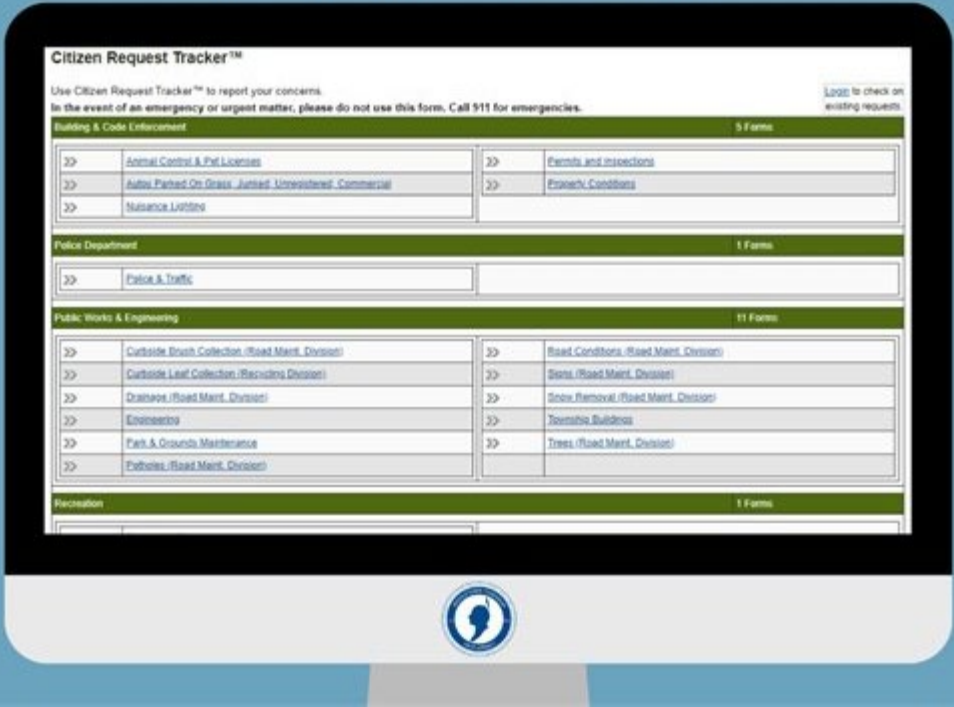
**Know Someone with a Disability?
