There are also 2 white flags that represent all individuals who lost their lives to an overdose throughout 2024.

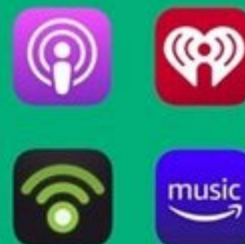

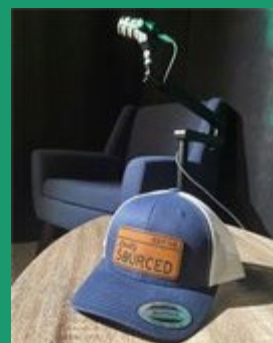

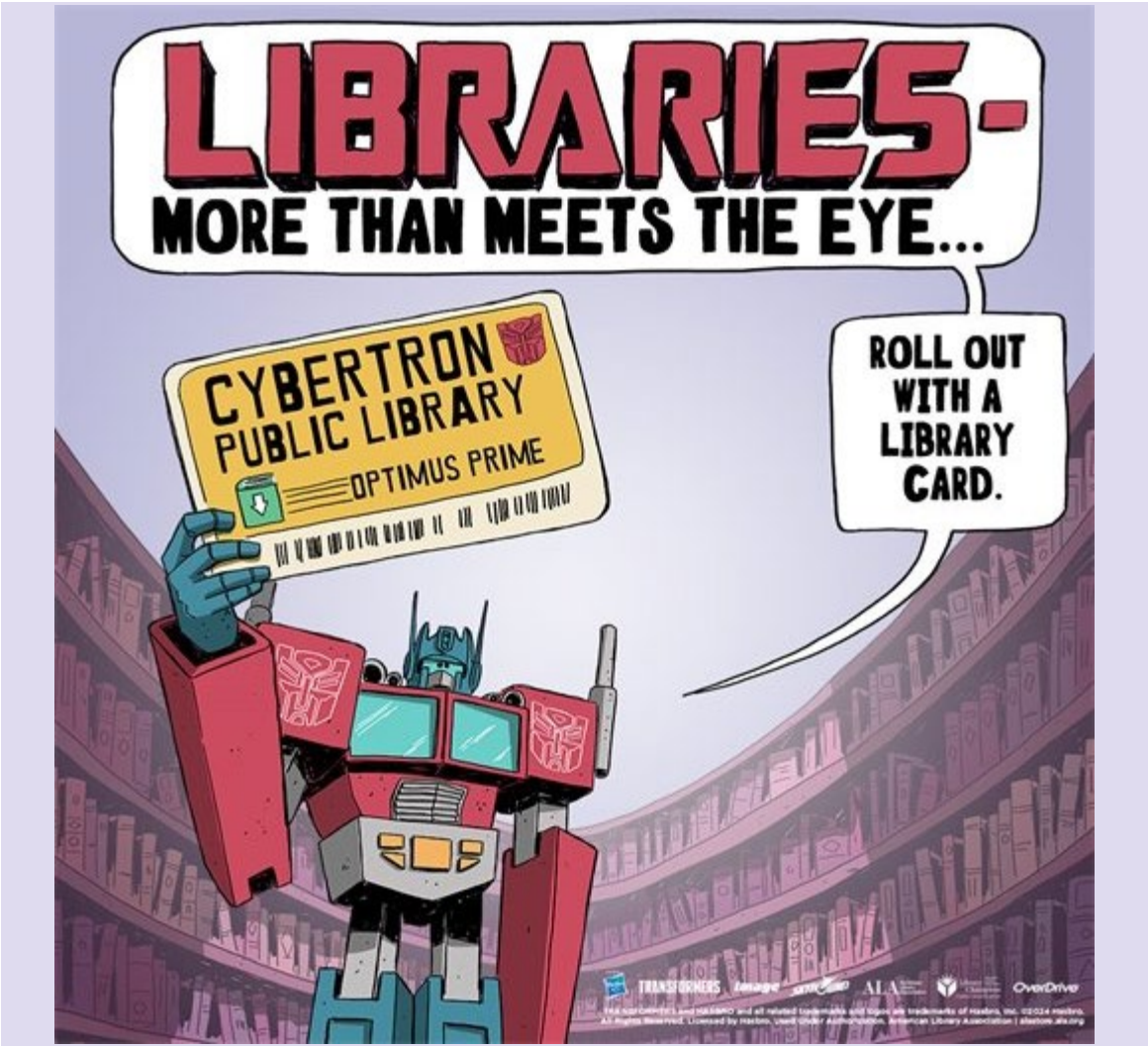
