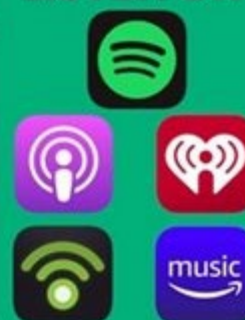


9/27/24 Rabies Alert: Rabid Raccoon Found Near Hartshorne Road

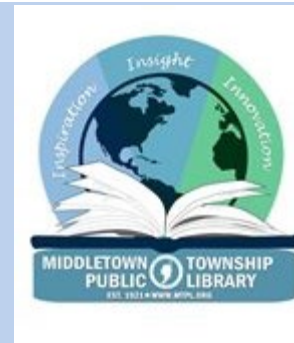

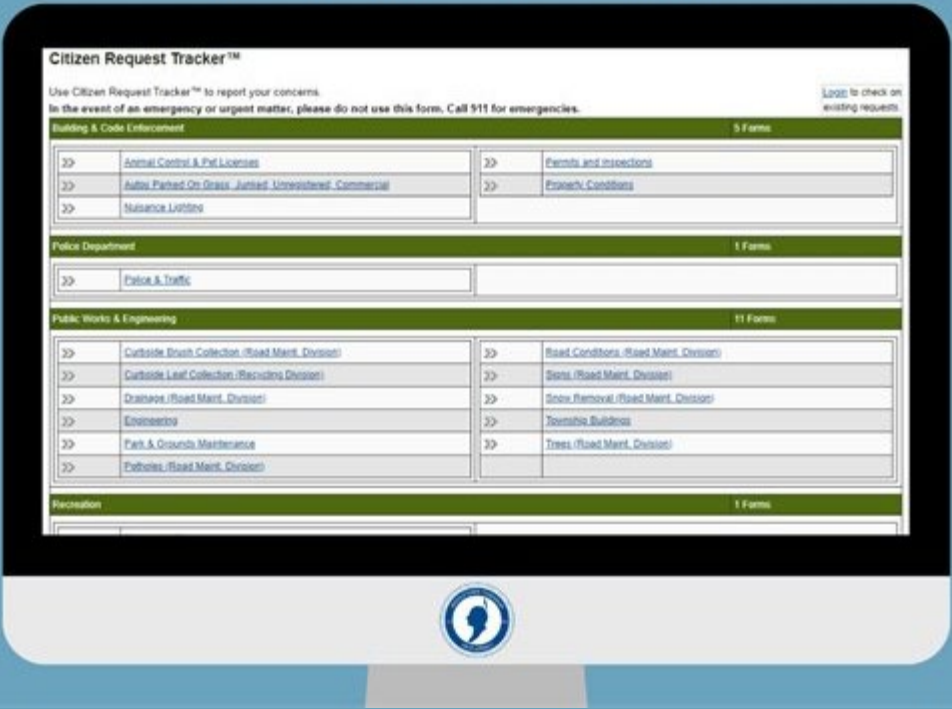
**Know Someone with a Disability?
