




**Donate to Hurricane Helene Relief Drive on Sunday, 10/13

## Murray Farmhouse Restoration Project Update




**Restorations to the Murray Farmhouse, located at Poricy Park (345 Oak Hill Road), began in July. The Township is investing nearly \$400,000 to preserve and update this historic landmark. This week, the Township's historic architects reevaluated the conditions of the farmhouse after its new roof was installed.**

After their assessment, the architects determined that the building needs more repairs before the project can begin the last phase, which is painting the building. This was expected to happen over the next few weeks but is now being planned for the spring.






Know Someone with a Disability?
