



A REMINDER TO LEAVE FAWNS ALONE

A fawn is not strong enough to follow its mom around, so she will put her baby in a very specific spot until she returns around dusk. The fawn knows to stay still, be quiet, and wait for her return.

Please DO NOT pick up or offer food or water to the fawn. The fawn's little heart can't handle the stress which can cause its death.

If you notice a fawn surrounded by flies, continuously crying, or with severely curled ears, please contact Middletown Animal Control immediately.

If you feel an animal is sick, injured, or abandoned, please call Middletown Animal Control during normal business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM) at 732-615-2097. After hours and on weekends, please call the Middletown Township Police Department at 732-615-2100.
