




"Middletown Remembers" September 11th Tribute



HOME REHABILITATION PROGRAM**

Tonya Keller Community Center, 50 Bray Avenue, North Middletown

If you are a Middletown homeowner, you may be eligible for a home rehabilitation grant of up to \$25,000 from the Township's Home Rehabilitation Program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The Home Rehab Program assists low- and moderate- income households to repair or replace older systems in the home such as plumbing, heating, roof, or electric. Handicap accessibility improvements are also eligible.

The Director of Community Development will be available at the next Ideal Beach Community Association meeting for questions on Tuesday, September 10th at 7pm at the Tonya Keller Community Center, 50 Bray Avenue in North Middletown. The facility is handicap accessible. Applications will be available for distribution.

Oceanic Bridge Test Lifts Scheduled for Next Week

Starting Monday, September 9th through Friday, September 13th, the Monmouth County Bridge Division will be performing routine maintenance and test lifts to the Oceanic Bridge between the hours of 9:00 AM to 2:30 PM between Middletown and Rumson. The bridge will open more than usual and remain open for 10-15 minutes at a time. Motorists should expect delays and seek alternate routes.

Monmouth & Navesink Avenue Road Closure Update

Gray Supply has been working in the area of Monmouth Avenue and Navesink Avenue replacing gas lines. They are anticipating the work will be completed this month. While they are working roads will be intermittently closed in the area and detours will be in place.

Route 35 Construction Project

Construction work on Route 35 began Monday, May 6th northbound from Cooper's Bridge (Red Bank) to Cherry Tree Farm Road and southbound from Cherry Tree Farm Road to New Monmouth Road.

Road work will be done with temporary lane closures from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM and from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM. All work is weather-dependent.

The project, which consists of repairs and replacement of concrete vertical curb, installation of public curb ramps, repairs to drainage structures and resurfacing of

the roadway, is estimated to be completed by December 2019.

Please keep an eye out for possible changes to the schedule.

- Southside Ave. & Portland Rd., Middletown
