Tony Perry Expected to Serve as Mayor for Third Consecutive Year



When the Township reorganizes at its virtual meeting on Sunday, January 3rd, the governing body is expected to elect Tony Perry to serve as Mayor for the third consecutive year. This is the first time in over 45 years that a mayor has served three years in a row since Mayor Thomas J. Lynch (1972-1974). Rick Hibell is anticipated to be chosen as Deputy Mayor, which will be his first time serving in this role.


“It has been an incredible honor to serve as Mayor over the last two years and I look forward to continuing the important work that is ongoing in 2021,” said Mayor Tony Perry.

Holiday Collection Schedule

Due to the New Year's Day holiday, SOUTH ZONE garbage collection for this Friday, 1/1/21, will be postponed.

The SOUTH ZONE will have DOUBLE COLLECTION of GARBAGE on Tuesday, 1/5/21. Residents may leave up to 3 closed garbage bags next to the cart. Please do not block the cart with the bags.

As a reminder, because of the postponed collection on Christmas day, the SOUTH ZONE will have a DOUBLE COLLECTION of BULK on your next bulk collection date, Friday, 1/8/21. Residents may leave up to 8 bulk items at the curb.

The Middletown Recycling Center (52 Kanes Lane) will be open for recycling on the Saturday and Sunday following New Year's Day. As a reminder, the satellite Middletown Train Station Recycling Center is open 24/7.

- Call when you arrive to be allowed into the building


