An experienced guide will provide you with a trowel and sifter, as well as help you identify your treasures.

CSI Virtual Crime Scene Class

This is a virtual program about STEM principles relating to forensics and solving crime scenes. The presentation, labs and exercises will cover: making a magnifying glass, taking and identifying fingerprints, creating and examining blood splatter patterns, identifying an unknown powder, chromatography, time-of-death exercises, casting footprints, and missing persons.

Refund Policy

In accordance with Township Ordinance, programs canceled by the Department of Recreation will be granted a full refund without any processing fee. All refunds or cancellation requests must be made in writing with a Refund Request Form. Additional documentation may be required. All requests will be honored in the following manner: (1) Refund/Cancellations received 14 days prior to program/activity start date to receive a full refund, less processing fee. (2) Cancellations/changes received 7-13 days prior to program/activity start date are eligible for a 50% refund, less processing fee. (3) Cancellations/Changes made less than seven days prior to program dates are not eligible for a refund. (4) For all Summer Recreation programs, no refunds will be granted after May 15. (5) A processing fee will be charged for all approved changes or refunds. (6) Participants requesting a refund must present proof of payment. (7) Approved Refunds will be issued via Purchase Order in six to eight weeks after approval. If possible, a credit on the participant's account may be offered as a refund instead. Registration refund processing fee: \$10.
