**2018 Summary of Complaints and Dispositions Received by the Middletown Twp. Police**

In 2018, the Middletown Twp. Police Department Office of Professional Standards received a total of 18 complaints. 66.6% of the complaints came from citizen complainants. 33.3% were agency complaints. The complaints, categorized according to the New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines, included the following:
