3 rd full dose/booster (same ml) at least 6 months from 2 nd dose for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • individuals 65 and older • Long-Term Care residents • Anyone 18-64 years of age with underlying medical conditions • Individuals who work in healthcare settings or an occupation that makes them high-risk for contracting COVID 	3 rd full dose for those who have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood • Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system • Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system • Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome) • Advanced or untreated HIV infection • Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response 	
	Booster (half dose)– six months or more after their initial series for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 65 years and older • Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings • Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions • Age 18+ who work or live in high-risk settings
