recycling tip of the week

BATTERIES!

Believe it or not, improper disposal of batteries is the number one cause of fires in landfills, recycling facilities and hauling trucks. By taking the extra steps to properly throw away batteries, you can reduce the potential risk to people, property, and the environment.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF BATTERIES:

- ALKALINE BATTERIES:** Common household alkaline batteries are considered nonhazardous. You may throw out alkaline batteries with ordinary trash.
- BUTTON CELL BATTERIES** (such as remote car starters and watches): These batteries contain mercury and must be brought to the Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility (3211 Shafto Road in Tinton Falls).
- CAR BATTERIES:** Residents may bring car batteries to the Middletown Recycling Center (52 Kanes Lane) free of charge.
- RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES** (such as cell phones, laptops, power tools, e-cigarettes and iPads): These items can be recycled at many home improvement stores, including Lowes and Home Depot.



Who can get a booster shot or third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine?

Everyone ages 12 and older should get a booster shot. Those ages 12 through 17 are only eligible for a Pfizer booster.
