recycling tip of the week

DISPOSABLE CUPS!

PAPER

- Check your lid! Numbers 1, 2, and 5 can be recycled. Other numbers can be disposed of in the trash.
- Cardboard sleeves are paper and recyclable!
- Hot paper cups are lined with plastic to prevent leaks which make them unable to be recycled. You can dispose of these in the trash.

PLASTIC

- Remember, straws cannot be recycled and must be disposed of in the trash.
- Plastic cups numbers 1, 2, and 5 can be recycled. Other numbers can be disposed of in the trash.

STYROFOAM

- Polystyrene and Styrofoam cups cannot be recycled and must be disposed of in the trash.

Who can get a booster shot or third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine?

Everyone ages 12 and older should get a booster shot. Those ages 12 through 17 are only eligible for a Pfizer booster.
