The Middletown Recycling Center (52 Kanes Lane) will be closed to complete renovations through the end of the month and is scheduled to re-open on Friday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Renovations began at the end of June, including increasing access and efficiency to the recycling drop-off bins, improving traffic circulation, allowing room for the expansion of recyclable commodities in the future, and ensuring ADA compliance to both the Middletown Recycling Center and Administrative Building. ## Low-Flying Helicopter Patrolling JCP&L Transmission Lines Through August 18<sup>th</sup>




Jersey Central Power & Light (JCP&L) would like to advise the community that Helo-Air will be mobilizing to the JCP&L Region from 8/11/22 – 8/18/22 and will

begin performing Routine patrols on all JCPL 500kV, 230kV, 115kV lines (weather-permitting). These patrols are expected to take approximately one week to complete, but as always, work is strongly weather-dependent and completion could be impeded by any post-storm or outage-related patrols that may occur.

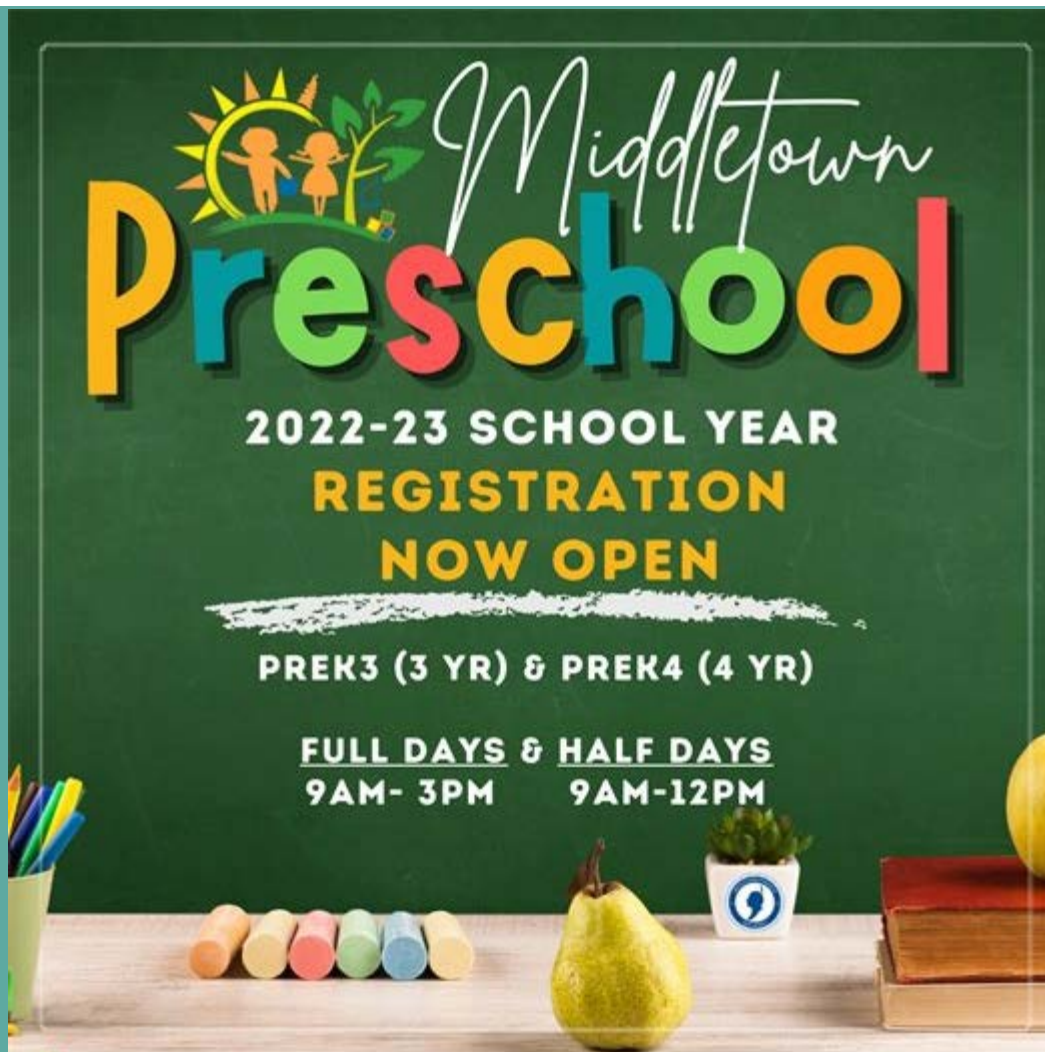



## Spotted Lanternflies Have Returned: Tips for How to Prevent the Spread and Report Sightings to NJDA

Spotted lanternflies are being spotted everywhere! This insect is a serious invasive pest that feeds on sap from over 70 different plant species. Spotted lanternflies can negatively impact our agriculture, economy, and everyday life through the honeydew they excrete, which eventually turns into mold.



The Middletown Health Department advises residents to kill and [report them to the NJDA](#) when spotted. The Middletown Health Department also encourages residents to utilize the NJDA's checklist for spotted lanternfly quarantine areas, in an effort to stop the spread.

## Monkeypox Vaccination in New Jersey

**Who can get vaccinated?**

The vaccine for monkeypox is called JYNNEOS. With the current limited supply of JYNNEOS vaccine in New Jersey, the following residents may be eligible for vaccination\*:

- People who have known contact with someone who tested positive for orthopoxvirus or monkeypox virus within past 14 days  
(Contact your local health department to coordinate vaccination)
- People who attended an event where known monkeypox exposure occurred within past 14 days  
(Make an appointment at a vaccine location) →
- People who had multiple sex partners in the past 14 days in areas where monkeypox has been reported  
(Make an appointment at a vaccine location) →

Anyone who attests to their eligibility (having multiple sex partners or attending an event where monkeypox exposure took place) is eligible for vaccination.

Current vaccination efforts focus on disproportionately affected groups, including gay and bisexual men, and other men who have sex with men. This may change over time.

\*New Jersey is expecting additional doses from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and as the State gets additional supply the Department will continue to expand access to the vaccine.

**HIGH PRIORITY GROUPS**

Residents who are eligible for vaccination and who also have a condition that may increase their risk for severe disease should be considered high priority for vaccination, including people who:

- Have a weakened immune system
- Have a history of atopic dermatitis or eczema
