The Middletown Township Health Department and Monmouth County are offering free children's immunizations on the third Thursday of each month from 10 AM - 1 PM at the Middletown Township Health Department. Participants must meet the following requirements to make an appointment:

- Patients must be between the ages of birth to 18 years old.
- Patients need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Patients should either have no health insurance or only be on the NJ Family Care Plan A.
- Patients are required to bring their immunization records.

Appointments are required and can be scheduled by calling 732-431-7456.



NJAW Conducting Annual Hydrant Flushing: Discolored Water is Harmless and Normal

New Jersey American Water (NJAW) is flushing the pipes in its water distribution system from approximately March 6th to May 12th in Middletown. During this time, you may notice a drop in water pressure or discolored water. This is normal. If this happens,

it is not harmful. Simply let your water run until it is clear.




NJNG Offers In-Person Energy Assistance to Customers through Friday, 6/30
